SNACS Systems Navigators Go the Extra Mile to Support Exceptional Families

Across Army installations, SNACS Systems Navigators (SN) are making a meaningful difference in the lives of military families enrolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP).

At Camp Humphreys, the SNACS SN team collaborated with Army Community Services (ACS) to establish a unique Lending Locker tailored for exceptional families. This initiative offers a variety of therapeutic and developmental tools, helping families settle into their new environment.

At Ft. Drum, they launched a sensory room and resource library that provides a calming, engaging environment for children with special needs, while the library gives families access to helpful resources. These spaces were created in response to direct feedback from families.

Through these efforts, SNACS SN continue to go above and beyond, bridging gaps in services and creating inclusive, supportive communities for exceptional families across the Army.

AWF2 Care Event and Air Force Marine Corps Trials

In March, the Air Force Wounded Warrior Program (AFW2) hosted the South-Central CARE Event and the Air Force and Marine Corps Trials at Joint Base San Antonio. Over 100 AF Warriors participated in the CARE Event in Resiliency, Empowerment to Employment (E2E), Recovering Airman Mentorship Program (RAMP), and Adaptive Sports.

The RAMP team is responsible for pairing new Warriors entering the program with Warrior Mentors. This mentorship provides the new Warriors with someone who shares a similar injury or illness and can relate to their experience. During CARE events, RAMP coordinators conduct a one-day workshop to train new mentors, equipping them with the tools needed for a successful two-year mentorship commitment. Additionally, mentors are embedded into tracks and sports teams during the events to promote the program and facilitate on-the-spot pairings with new Warriors.

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Recovering service members from the US Air Force, Marine Corps, and Army and international teams from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Georgia competed in Trials.

The participants finishing at the top from the Air Force and Marine Corps were selected to participate in the 2025 Warrior Games planned for July 17-26 in Colorado Springs, CO.
